#### Instructions

#### Head

- 1. With the skin color yarn, ch 4 and join to form a ring.
- 2. Round 1: Ch 1, sc 6 into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (6 sc)
- 3. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sc 2 into each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)

- 4. **Round 3:** Ch 1, \*sc 1, inc\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc)
- 5. **Round 4:** Ch 1, \*sc 2, inc\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (24 sc)
- 6. **Rounds 5-7:** Ch 1, sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (24 sc each round)
- Round 8: Ch 1, \*sc 2, dec\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc)
- Round 9: Ch 1, \*sc 1, dec\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
- 9. **Round 10:** Ch 1, sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
- 10. Stuff the head with polyester stuffing.
- 11. Close the opening by sc around the edge. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

#### Body

- 1. With the skin color yarn, ch 4 and join to form a ring.
- 2. Round 1: Ch 1, sc 6 into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (6 sc)
- 3. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sc 2 into each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
- Round 3: Ch 1, \*sc 1, inc\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc)
- 5. **Round 4:** Ch 1, \*sc 2, inc\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (24 sc)

- 6. Round 5: Ch 1, sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (24 sc)
- Rounds 6-10: Ch 1, \*sc 2, dec\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc each round)
- Round 11: Ch 1, \*sc 1, dec\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
- 9. **Round 12:** Ch 1, sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
- 10. Stuff the body with polyester stuffing.
- 11. Close the opening by sc around the edge. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

#### Arms

- 1. With the skin color yarn, ch 4 and join to form a ring.
- 2. Round 1: Ch 1, sc 6 into the ring. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (6 sc)
- 3. **Round 2:** Ch 1, sc 2 into each sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (12 sc)
- Round 3: Ch 1, \*sc 1, inc\* around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc)
- 5. Round 4: Ch 1, sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc)
- 6. **Rounds 5-8:** Ch 1, sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (18 sc each round)
- 7. Round 9: Ch 1, sc 2, dec, sc 15, dec, sc 2. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (16 sc)
- 8. **Round 10:** Ch 1, sc around. Join with a sl st to the first sc. (16 sc)

- 9. Stuff the arms with polyester stuffing.
- 10. Close the openings by sc around the edges. Join with a sl st to the first sc.

#### Hair

- 1. With the hair color yarn, ch 60.
- 2. Sc into the second ch from the hook and each ch to the end. (59 sc)
- 3. Turn and ch 1.
- 4. Sc into each sc across. (59 sc)
- 5. Repeat steps 3-4 until the hair is long enough. (About 12 inches)
- 6. Cut the yarn and leave a long tail. Thread the tail through the top of the doll's head. Tie a knot to secure.

### Eyes

1. With black embroidery thread, embroider two small circles on the doll's face for the eyes.

#### Nose

1. With black embroidery thread, embroider a small triangle on the doll's face for the nose.

### Mouth

1. With black embroidery


