* Slip stitch to the base of any chain loop. * Double crochet (dc) into the chain. * *Chain 1, dc into the next chain loop.* * Repeat steps 7-8 two more times. * You should now have a triangle shape. * Slip stitch to the base of the next chain loop and repeat steps 6-8 to create the next triangle. * Continue this process until all chains around the hoop are filled with triangles.

5. Weave the Web

* Cut a long piece of yarn (worsted weight or embroidery floss) and attach it to any corner of the hoop. * Decide where you want the center of your dream catcher to be and thread the yarn through the center hole of the hoop. * Bring the yarn up through the center of one of your triangles. * Loop the yarn around the top point of the triangle and bring it back down. * Repeat steps 13-14 to create spokes radiating from the center. * Connect the spokes by weaving the yarn back and forth between them.

6. Embellish and Personalize

* Wrap the wooden hoop with embroidery floss or yarn in a color of your choice. * Attach beads, feathers, charms, or other embellishments to the

dream catcher for a more personal touch.

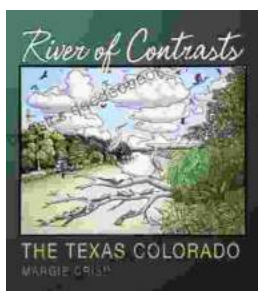
