- 3 Skeins of 3mm macrame cord in natural and colored tones
- 1 Bamboo ring (8 inches in diameter)

- 1. Cut 24 cords in natural color, each measuring 8 yards long.
- 2. Cut 12 cords in the colored tone, each measuring 6 yards long.
- 3. Attach the natural-colored cords to the bamboo ring using Lark's Head Knots.

- 5. Knot a row of square knots with one group of colored cords between each group of natural-colored cords.

- 6. Repeat step 5 on the other side of the bag.
- 7. Continue knotting rows until the bag reaches the desired height.
- 8. Trim the excess cords at the bottom of the bag.
- 9. Add decorative tassels or fringe to the base of the bag.

#### Pattern 3: The Open Weave Market Bag

- 2 Skeins of 4mm macrame cord
- 2 Wooden handles (6 inches long)

- 1. Cut 16 cords, each measuring 12 yards long.
- 2. Attach the cords to both handles using Lark's Head Knots.
- 3. Divide the cords into 4 equal groups of 4 cords each.
- 4. Knot a row of square knots with the first two groups of cords.
- 5. Skip one cord from each of the third and fourth groups and knot a row of square knots.
- 6. Repeat steps 4 and 5 until the bag reaches the desired height.
- 7. Trim the excess cords at the bottom of the bag.

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
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
